

COVID POLICY

Our guidelines for the 2021 Convention are as follows:

- We shall follow the Vermont Department of Health guidelines in effect for Orleans County (Jay Peak) on the date of our Convention;
- We shall ask all members to wear a mask in large group settings, in the Convention Hall, when not speaking from the podium;
- We encourage ALL non-vaccinated members and those who have health concerns to wear a mask at all times when not in a private setting;
- We shall provide free masks for all members;
- We shall make hand sanitizer available to all members;
- We encourage members, delegates, and guests to NOT double up on rooms, and for hotel rooms to contain only their family unit/pod (and to better guarantee this, the VT AFL-CIO is paying for the first 124 rooms that will be used for our Convention);
- We shall disinfect microphones in between use by different speakers.
- We request that all members refrain from attending if they have a fever or are suffering from any symptoms which may indicate an illness of any kind.
